Dr. Ghazali is currently working as the director of the Houston Quran Academy. He is also a consultant for several Islamic schools. He also works as a professor with Alhuda University in Houston, Texas. He serves as the chairman of MAS Council of Islamic Schools (MASCIS). He has published several papers and articles on Islamic education. Dr. Ghazali is an expert on K-12 school accreditation. He helped several Islamic schools get accredited. Dr. Ghazali has memorized the entire Quran and did extensive research
